

## Plickers (paper clickers): <https://plickers.com/>

1. Create a free account.
2. Verify email.
3. Create questions (M/C or T/F).
4. Print cards
  - a. Up to 63
  - b. Free
  - c. Adam Paape laminated them so they would last longer (not required).
5. Create a class
  - a. Can manually type in names
  - b. Can upload a list of names
6. Add the questions you plan to use to your class Question Queue
7. Download the Plicker app (smartphone or tablet) and sign in. App and account will synch.
8. When ready to poll:
  - a. Hand out cards according to roster.
  - b. Bring up Live View for students to see question.
  - c. Can control view of question from the app.
  - d. Click Scan when ready to gather results.
  - e. Click OK when done.
