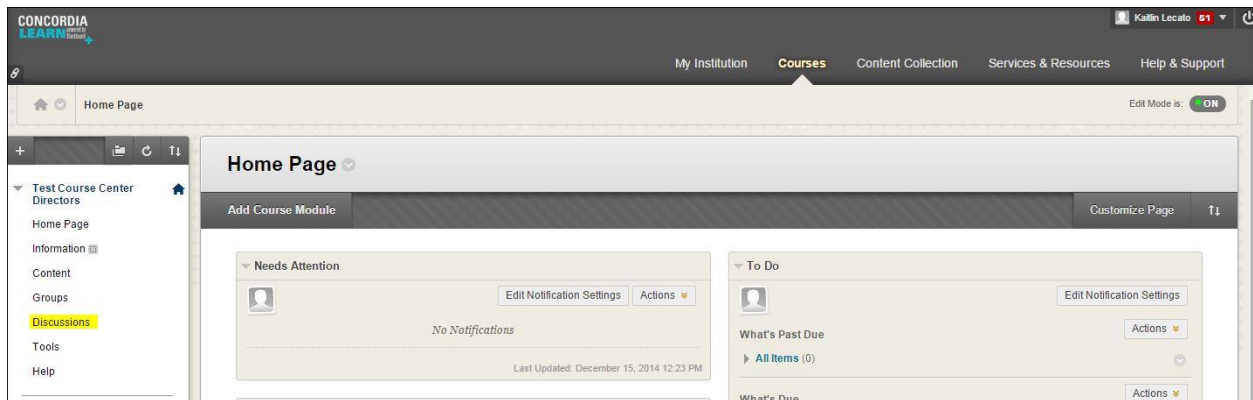
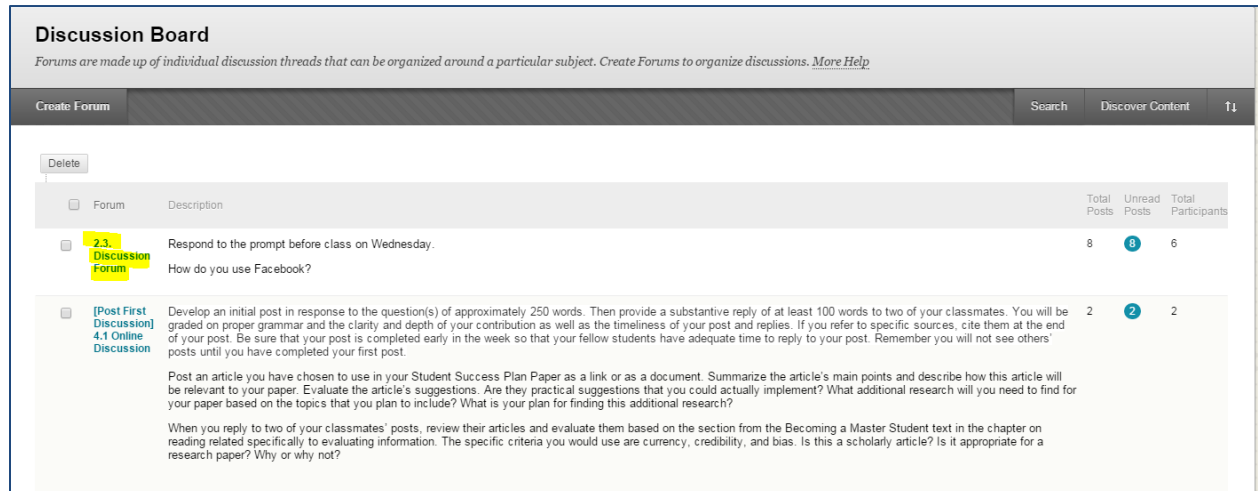


Discussion Board Views – How to view all posts in a forum

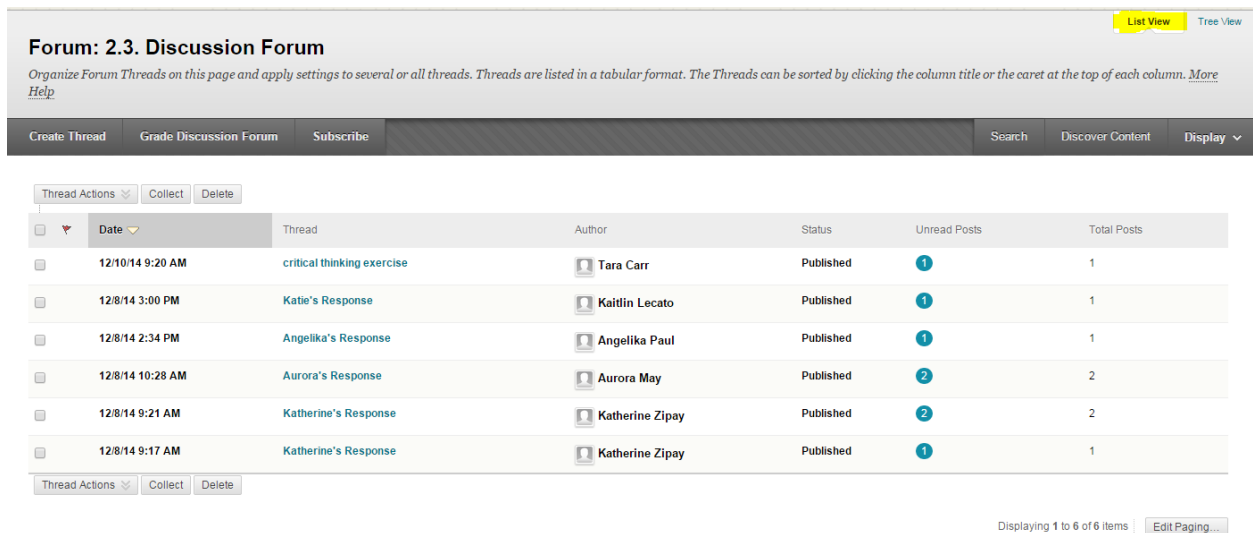
1. In your course, click on “Discussions”.



2. Click on the name of the discussion forum you want to view.



3. In the upper right corner, check that the view is set to “list view”.



- To view all posts, click the box at the top (near the red flag) to select all posts. Click “Collect”.
